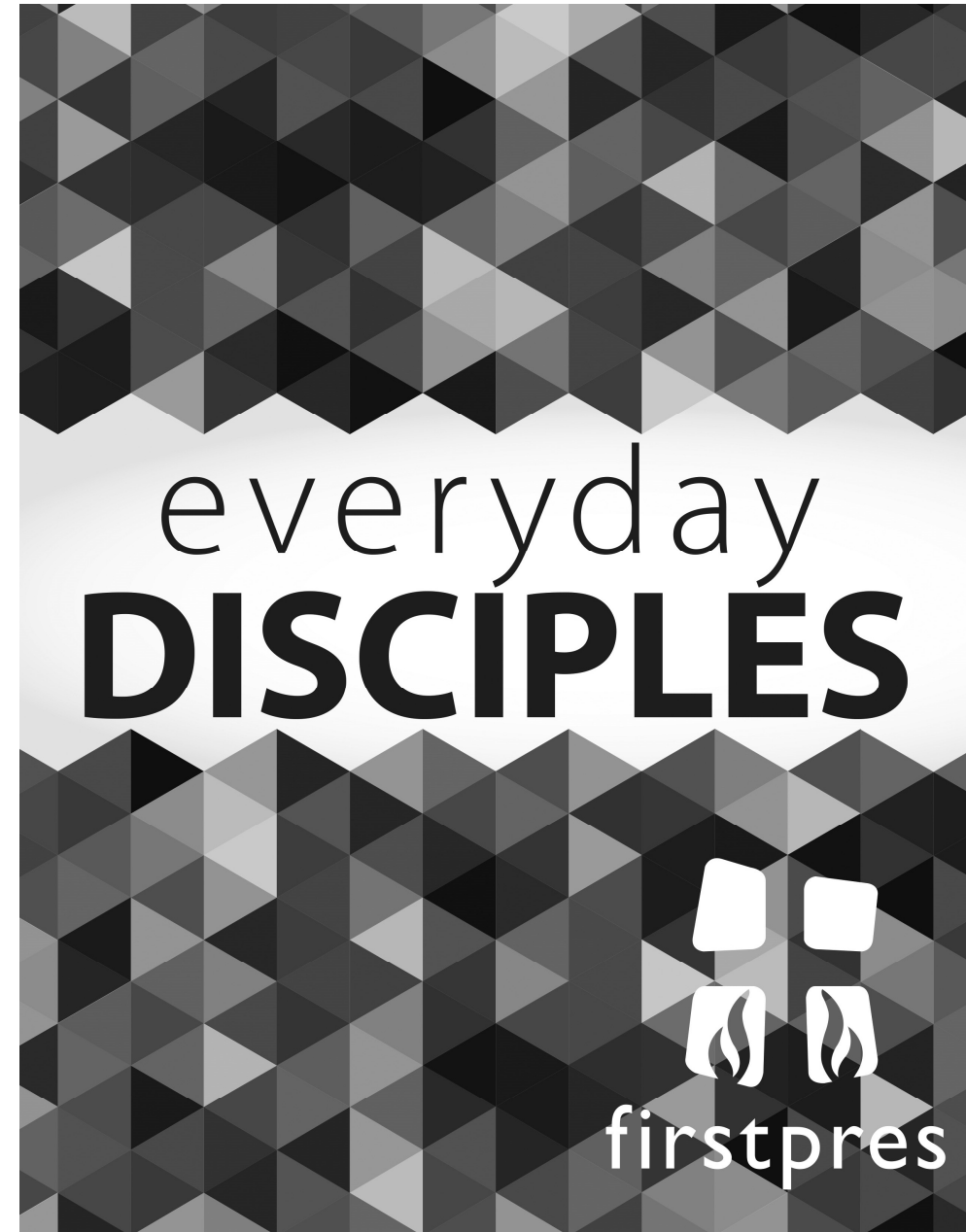
Tuesday, February 20th 10:00am
