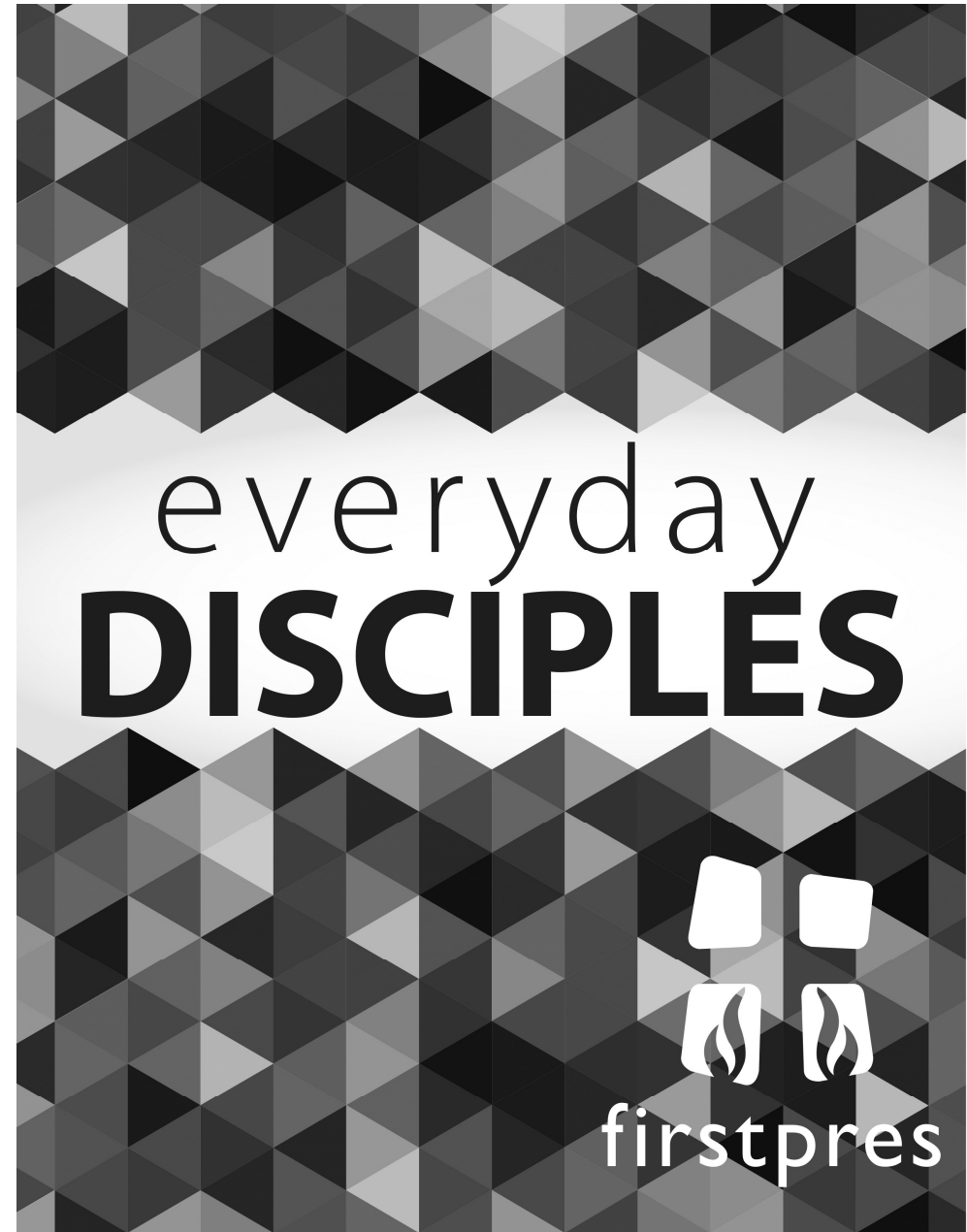
**Salvation Army Stockings**
