We will have worship in the Family Life Center with Salem Presbyterian Church.

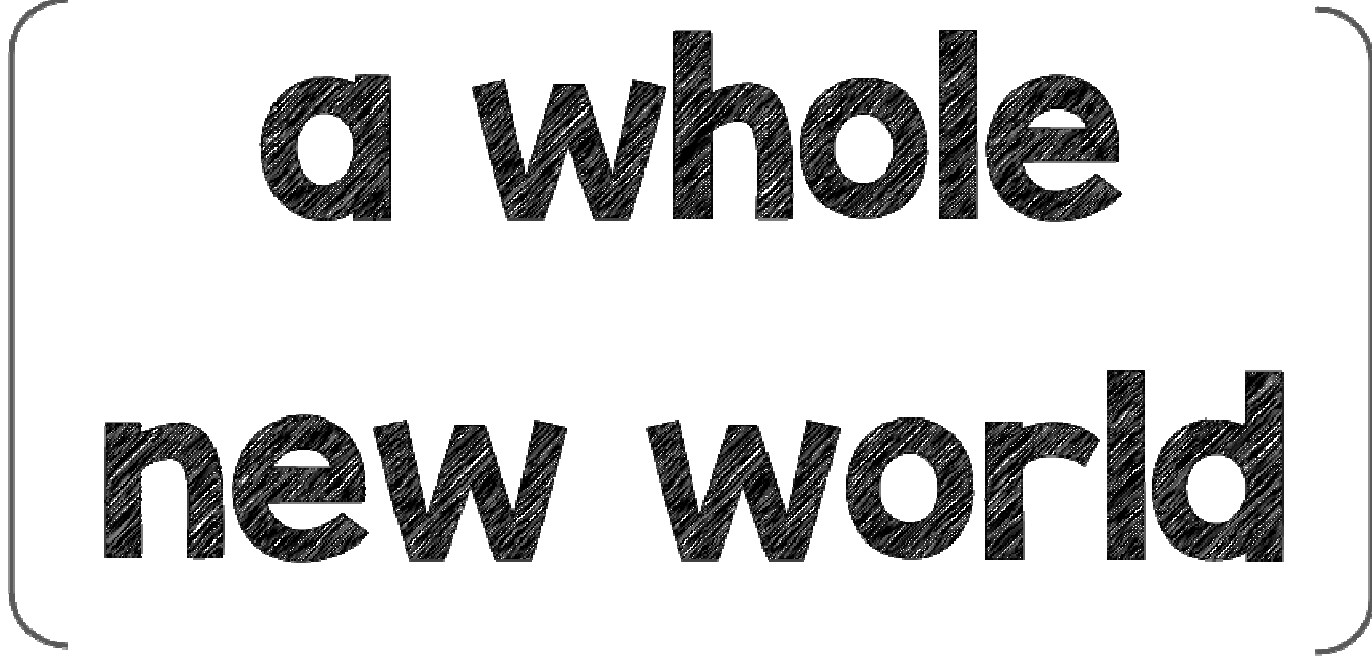
After worship we will enjoy lunch together. Main dish, dessert and drinks will be provided. Please bring a side to share (please bring serving utensil).
